Oil transportation through the system of main oil pipelines of KazTransOil JSC is carried out in a regular mode

In the conditions of an emergency situation due to floods in 10 regions of the Republic of Kazakhstan, the system of main oil pipelines of KazTransOil JSC operates normally.

There is no threat of flooding of production facilities of KazTransOil JSC.

Oil transportation to refineries of the Republic of Kazakhstan and to export destinations is carried out in accordance with the schedule approved by the Ministry of Energy of the Republic of Kazakhstan. The transit of Russian oil to China and Uzbekistan is also carried out in a stable mode.

The production facilities of MunaiTas LLP, Kazakh-Chinese Pipeline LLP, and Main Water Pipeline LLP are operating normally.

For reference:

KazTransOil JSC is the national operator of the main oil pipeline. It is part of the NC KazMunayGas JSC group. KazTransOil JSC owns a diversified network of main oil pipelines 5.4 thousand km in length.

Kazakhstan-China Pipeline LLP is a joint venture of KazTransOil JSC (50%) and China National Oil and Gas Exploration and Development Company Ltd. (50%), owning the Kenkiyak - Kumkol and Atasu - Alashankou main oil pipelines.

MunaiTas LLP is a joint venture of KazTransOil JSC (51%) and CNPC Exploration and Development Company Ltd (49%), established in order to implement a project for the design, financing, construction and operation of the Kenkiyak – Atyrau oil trunk pipeline.

KazTransOil JSC owns 100% of the shares in the authorized capital of Main waterline LLP. Main waterline LLP is the owner of the Astrakhan - Mangyshlak main water pipeline.
