“KazTransOil” JSC announces about temporary suspension of oil transportation via the Atyrau-Samara section of the Uzen-Atyrau-Samara trunk pipeline

In connection with the termination of electricity supply (by KEGOC JSC, Atyrau Zharyk JSC) on January 10 and January 11, the transportation of oil on Atyrau-Samara section of Uzen-Atyrau-Samara trunk pipeline was suspended.

At present, KazTransOil JSC is working out alternative modes of operation of Uzen-Atyrau-Samara trunk oil pipeline.

After stabilization of the electricity supply by the power transmission organization, transportation will be resumed as planned on Atyrau-Samara section of Uzen-Atyrau-Samara trunk pipeline.

For reference:

“KazTransOil” JSC – the national operator of the Republic of Kazakhstan for the main oil pipeline. It is part of the “KazMunayGas” JSC Groups. It owns a diversified network of main oil pipelines with a length of 5.4 thousand km. Transports oil to Kazakhstan's refineries and for export in 5 directions: “Atyrau-Samara” and “Kazakhstan-China oil pipelines”, the port of Aktau (loading oil into tankers), transshipment to the CPC system, and the railway (loading into tanks). “KazTransOil” JSC's production facilities are located in Mangistau, Atyrau, West Kazakhstan, Aktobe, Pavlodar, Karaganda, Kyzylorda, Almaty, Turkestan, North Kazakhstan regions of Kazakhstan, Nur-Sultan and Shymkent.

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
