KazTransOil ensured delivery of 230 thousand tons of Kazakh oil to Germany in May

In May 2025, the volume of Kazakh oil transported via the trunk pipeline system of Transneft PJSC toward the oil delivery point "Adamova Zastava" for further delivery to Germany amounted to 230 thousand tons, setting a new record.

KazTransOil JSC ensures the transit of oil through the territory of the Russian Federation via the pipeline system of Transneft PJSC. From there, Kazakh oil is pumped through the territory of the Republic of Belarus via the pipeline system of Gomeltransneft Druzhba JSC to the "Adamova Zastava" delivery point for further transportation to the Schwedt oil refinery in Germany.

This transit is carried out under the framework of the relevant agreement between the Government of the Republic of Kazakhstan and the Government of the Russian Federation dated June 7, 2002.

KazTransOil JSC is the national operator of the Republic of Kazakhstan for the main oil pipeline. It is part of the KazMunayGas JSC NC group. The company owns a diversified network of main oil pipelines with a length of 5.2 thousand km and provides operator services for the maintenance of pipelines owned by third-party organizations, with a total length exceeding 5 thousand km.

KazTransOil JSC began supplying oil to Germany via the Druzhba pipeline in January 2023, with the delivery of the first pilot batch. In 2023, the total volume of Kazakh oil transported for further delivery to Germany amounted to 993 thousand tons. In 2024, this figure increased to 1.2 million tons. In the first five months of 2025, 767 thousand tons of oil have already been transported.

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
