On the appointment of Adil Mukhamejanov as the Chairman of KASE's Management Board

Kazakhstan Stock Exchange JSC (KASE) announces the appointment of Adil Nurlanovich Mukhamejanov as the Chairman of KASE's Management Board, effective March 31, 2025.

Adil Mukhamejanov possesses more than two decades of work experience in Kazakhstan's financial industry. He started his career in 2002 in the Department of Monetary Operations of the National Bank of the Republic of Kazakhstan, where he occupied several executive positions, including that of Deputy Director of the Department, supervising the execution of the monetary policy and the management of the National Fund's assets.

Later, Adil Nurlanovich took on the role of Deputy Chairman of KASE's Management Board, overseeing and coordinating trading and clearing operations. His guidance facilitated the successful launch of the foreign exchange market's trading and clearing system.

Before becoming Chairman of KASE's Management Board, Adil Mukhamejanov worked as the Chairman of the Management Board at the Central Securities Depository JSC. During his tenure, the Central Securities Depository effectively implemented its Development Strategy for 2022–2024, which included significant digital transformation and positioning of the institution as a regional depository hub.

KASE Clearing Centre (KACC) is a wholly owned subsidiary of KASE, which provides clearing, settlements and central counterparty functions on all KASE markets. Clearing is carried out on more than 1,500 financial instruments, including 989 issues of securities from 253 issuers listed on KASE.
